HbA1C testing

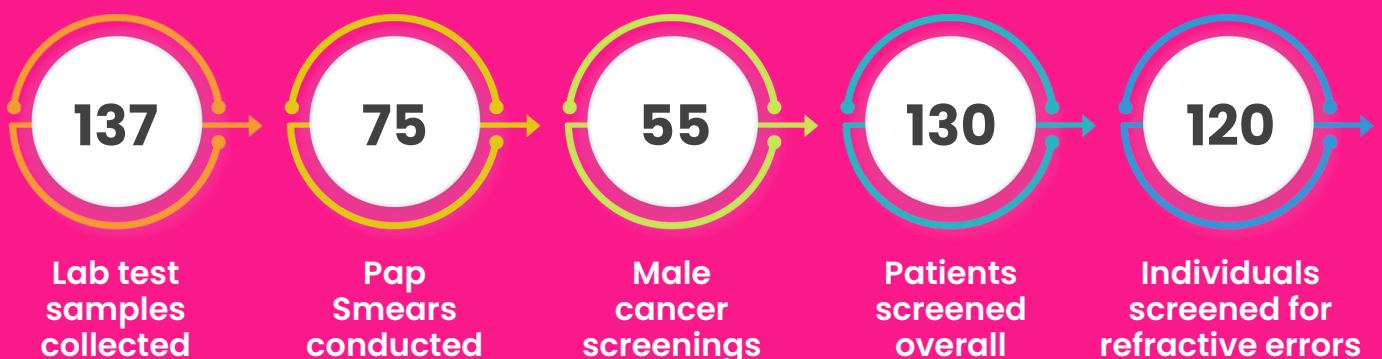

A delightful Wine & Cheese Workshop brought members and guests together for an engaging evening of flavours and fellowship.

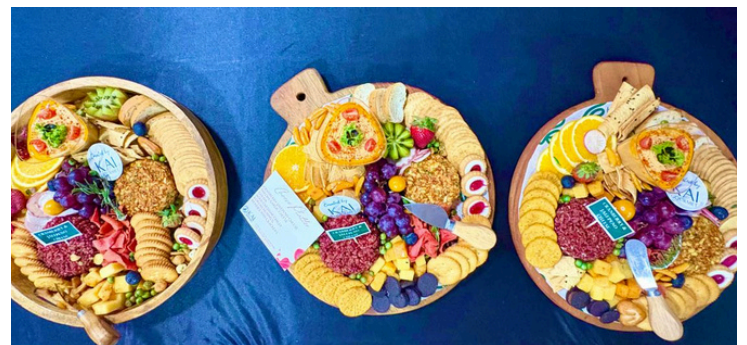
Sponsored by Good Drop Winery (Frizzano Wines), the session was led by wine connoisseur Vedant, who guided us through:

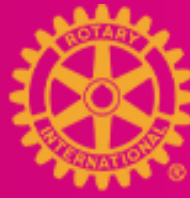
- A refreshing white wine
