Car Rally: Thrill on Wheels, Purpose in Motion

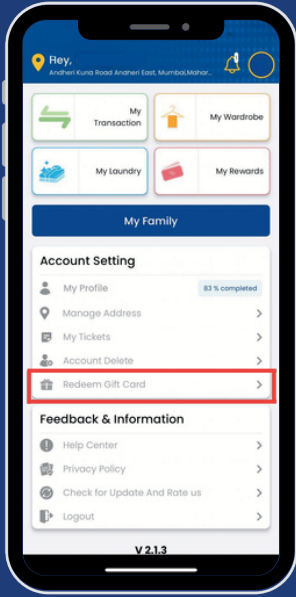
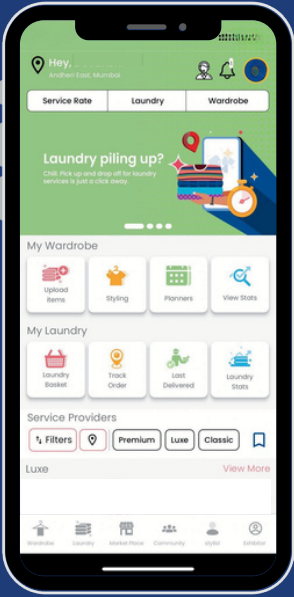

In yet another heartwarming step, our club recently set up pet shelters across Powai, offering safe havens for our four-legged friends who often go unnoticed in the hustle of city life.

Why Pet Shelters?

Powai, like most parts of Mumbai, has a growing community of stray dogs and cats. While local residents and animal lovers do their best to provide food and care, the lack of structured shelters has left many animals vulnerable to harsh weather, injuries, and neglect. Recognizing this gap, Lakers decided to take action by building sturdy, weather-proof shelters that provide safety and comfort.

The Lakers Touch

These shelters are not just functional, but thoughtfully designed:

Weather-Resistant Build – ensuring pets stay protected during Mumbai’s heavy monsoons and scorching summers.

Strategic Placement – installed at locations where stray animals are most often seen, ensuring they are accessible.

Community Care Model – residents are encouraged to add bowls of food and water, making it a collective effort in kindness.

Beyond Shelters: Building Compassion

This initiative is more than just about structures; it is about building a culture of compassion. The Lakers’ Pet Shelter Project has sparked conversations in housing societies, schools, and local groups about responsible co-existence with animals. Children, in particular, have shown great enthusiasm in decorating the shelters and naming the furry residents who frequent them.

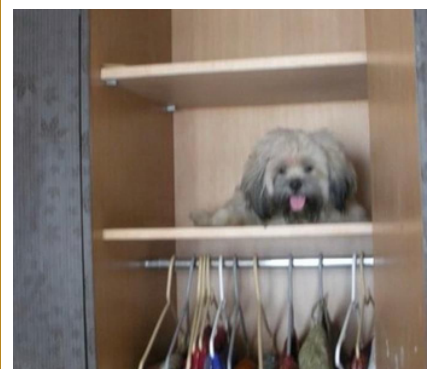
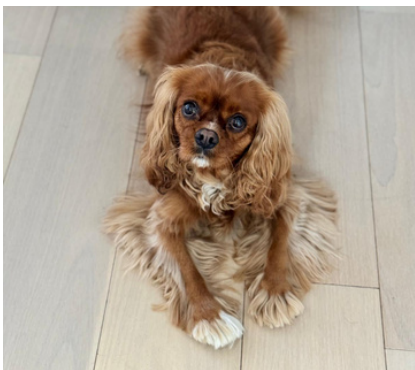
